

TRIBASE MILITARY COMMUNITY ADULT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Tribase Military Community Graduation Scholarships are co-sponsored by the Mildenhall Spouse Association (MSA) and the Liberty Spouses Association (LSA). The Community Scholarship Association (CSA) is the administering body of these clubs and annually awards the pledged scholarship funds. These scholarships seek to reward graduating seniors pursuing a degree at an accredited college, university or technical school.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must be adults (18 years or older, and *not* currently in high school) seeking postsecondary education. Applicants must reside in the local community and be co-located, dependents of military members or civilian employees of the Department of Defense, or a co-located dependent who otherwise qualifies for command sponsorship in the United Kingdom, at RAF Feltwell, Lakenheath, or Mildenhall. Applicants must possess a valid dependent ID. Applicants must submit a completed application no later than **Friday April 8, 2022**.

- *Please note that an application review will be offered to any applicant who submits their package by Friday February 25, 2022. This review will only verify that all necessary components of the application are included and does not offer preference over applications submitted beyond the review date.*

AWARDS:

The CSA determines the number of scholarships to be awarded and the monetary value of the scholarships based on available funds.

GENERAL INFORMATION/CRITERIA:

1. Scholarships are awarded for technical, bachelor, or graduate level courses.
2. The judging committee is comprised of diverse professionals who do not have an eligible dependent. One member of the judging committee will be from the CSA.
3. Applicants will be notified in writing of the results.
4. Applications are confidential and judged on the essay and completed application form.

AWARD USE:

1. Scholarship funds are to be used within the 2022-2023 academic year.
2. Scholarship funds are to be used for tuition, fees, books, and supplies at an accredited college, university, or technical school.
3. Scholarship recipients must provide the name and address of school attending to the CSA scholarship Chair no later than June 1, 2022. Payment of the scholarship money will be made directly to the selected school. After that time, unaccepted funds revert back to the CSA.

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APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

DO NOT attach a resume; it is not a substitute for the completed application.

1. Complete the boxes / grey fields. Application must be clearly printed in black ink or typed. If more space is needed for information on the application, please attach additional sheets with the last 4 of your DOD ID number (found on the ID card) in the bottom right hand corner. (DOD ID # is voluntary disclosure to ensure applications remain anonymous to judging committee).

Applicant must present application in person to thrift store and produce valid dependent ID at time of drop off.
